



## Halton Region Childcare Subsidies

You may be eligible for the municipal childcare subsidy!

In addition to the provincial childcare subsidy, Halton Region also provides childcare subsidy to offset the financial burden of parents for eligible families. The requirements you need to meet to be eligible are:

- You live in Halton Region. Oakville is in Halton Region.
- You are currently working, training, or attending school.
- You have children from birth to 12 years of age in licensed childcare programs.
- Your income is eligible for the childcare fee subsidy.

If you are a parent of a child with special needs who is 12 years old or younger, you may be eligible for childcare fee subsidy. Call 311 to find more information.

**Estimate Your Subsidy:** The maximum amount of childcare subsidy you will receive depends on your family's combined gross income and childcare costs.

### Halton Region Child Subsidy Application Process

**Before You Apply** – to start, confirm that you have done the following:

1. You have filed an income tax return\*
2. You have completed an Income Test
3. You can provide a recent copy of one of the following: Federal Notice of Assessment or Reassessment (NOA, 1-800-959-8281) or Child Care Benefit (1-800-387-1193).

\*Exemptions are made for recent immigrants who did not live in Canada in the previous year, thus had no income made in Canada to report.

**Online Application:** Fill out the application form online (<https://www.missioninc.com/olaf/halton/en-ca/welcome>) or call 311. Upon submission of your application, you will receive a confirmation email.

**After You Apply:** Upon receipt of your application, a Halton Region Children's Services Intake Worker will give you a call within 7 to 10 business days to discuss your application. We strongly advise that you have your Notice of Assessment or your Canada Child Benefit information available for this call.

**Once Approved ...Send Documents:** Children's Service will mail you a letter explaining all documents you need to send to finish the application process. It is crucial that you send all the required documents. If not, your application will be considered incomplete, and you will not receive the subsidy you are due.

**Confirmation:** You will receive an email confirmation from the Children's Service confirming the submission of your documents. This email will also tell you about the next steps in the application process.

If you need an interpreter, Halton Region will provide it at no cost. When you apply, let the childcare representative on the phone know that you need an interpreter.
